

Consideration of the world in basic human rights

Basic human rights are rights granted to and possessed by individuals. It requires a clear agreement that the world is obliged to provide a human life. This calls for the Supreme Court's judgment that it will not be taken away by criminals, and that the nation does not grant the human rights but inherent in humans, and that politics is responsible for it.

It is thought that the provision of standard living can be sought in the political consensus, along with the enforcement of basic income, in the political consensus and the provision to go with society. These can build a new social system as well as build a new efficient society and life in the changing reality.

The reality is the dichotomy of the reality and world. This is because there are two divisions, the elite and the excepted from reality. The provision of life to all these people can be done on the principle of equality.

These neosocialisms can realize the construction of a new society based on humanitarian judgment. These require politics to provide a solution to all inhumane realities. We believe that the strict demands on politics are due to the fact that reality is inconsistent and the problem, but that the solution of reality in the vulnerable is prioritized.
